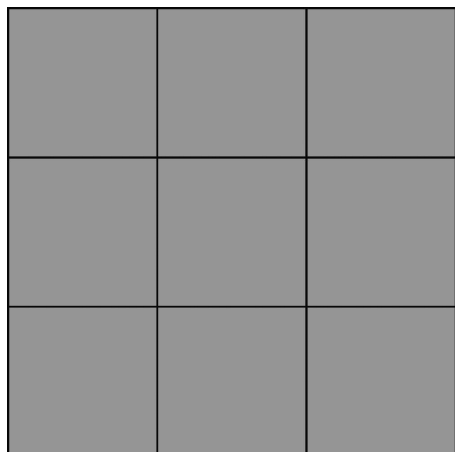


# Tile Shade Variation

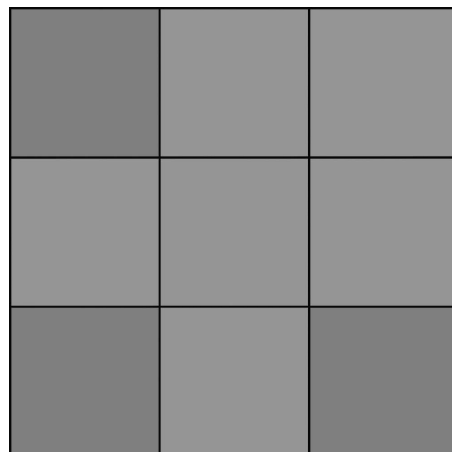
Shade variation is a natural characteristic of all tile products, including natural stone, porcelain, glass, and ceramic. Both shade and texture can vary significantly from tile to tile, even within the same production batch. Tiles are often categorised by the degree of variation, using a V1 to V4 rating system. A V1 shade variation indicates minimal or no noticeable difference between tiles, while a V4 rating reflects a wide range of colour and texture differences, giving a more dynamic and varied appearance.

It is essential that, before installation, the customer reviews and approves a selection of tiles to ensure they are satisfied with the range of variation. Once the tiles are installed, we cannot accept claims regarding shade or texture discrepancies.

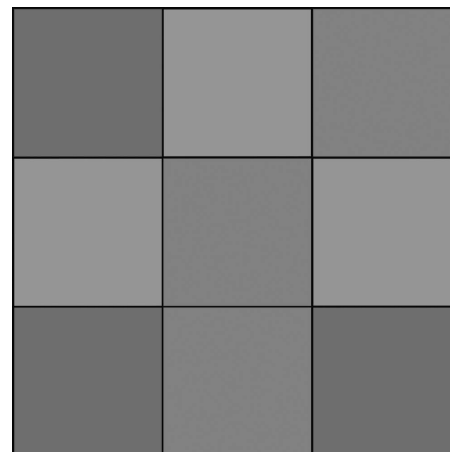
Please be aware that colours may appear differently on computer screens. To make an informed decision, we strongly recommend that customers request physical tile samples before finalising their selection or making a purchase.



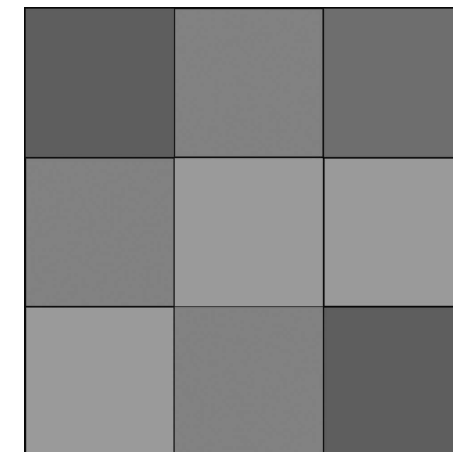
**V1 Low**

Product with light chromatic variation



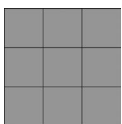
**V3 High**  
Product with high shade chromatic variation



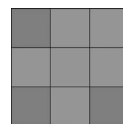
**V4 Extreme**

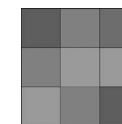
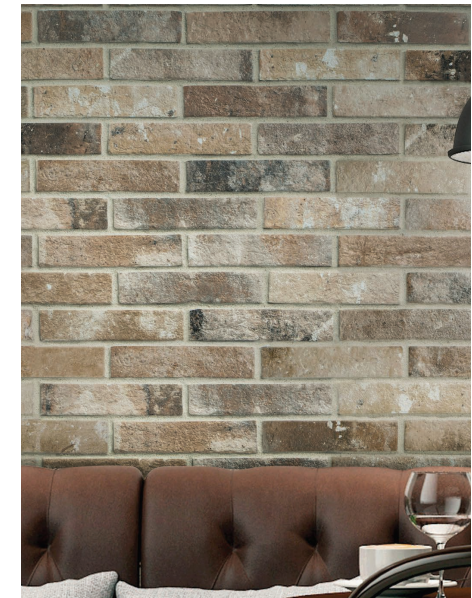
V1 Low
